Clearing Cache Files in a PC

Internet Explorer 4.x

From the menu bar, click **VIEW**,
Then from the drop down box menu choose **INTERNET OPTIONS**,
From the **GENERAL** tab
Go to the section titled **TEMPORARY INTERNET FILES**,
Click on the **DELETE FILES** button.
You might be prompted with a window that says, "You can delete all your
subscription content stored locally",
Leave the box unchecked, then hit **OK**, Then hit **OK** again.

Internet Explorer 5.x

From the menu bar, click **TOOLS**,
Then from the drop down box menu choose **INTERNET OPTIONS**,
From the **GENERAL** tab
Go to the section titled **TEMPORARY INTERNET FILES**,
Click on the **DELETE FILES** button.
You might be prompted with a window that says, "You can delete all your
subscription content stored locally",
Leave the box unchecked, then hit **OK**, Then hit **OK** again.

Netscape Communicator 4.x

From the menu bar, click **EDIT**,
Then from the drop down menu choose **PREFERENCES**,
On the left side of the window click the plus sign in front of the
Word **ADVANCED** and then highlight the word **CACHE**,
On the right side of the window click on the **CLEAR MEMORY CACHE NOW**
button and the **CLEAR DISK CACHE NOW** button.

Clearing Cache Files in a MACINTOSH

Internet Explorer 4.x

From the menu bar, click **EDIT**,
Then from the drop down menu choose **PREFERENCES**,
On the left side of the window open the **WEB BROWSER** category
Below that highlight **ADVANCED**
On the right side of the windows in the section titled **CACHE**, click the **EMPTY
NOW** button

Netscape 4.x

Same as a PC, except no clear memory cache button

Clearing Cookie Files in a PC

Internet Explorer

Click on the **START** button, then **FIND, FILES OR FOLDERS**

In the named filed type **COOKIES**

Make sure the **LOOK IN** filed is set to look in the entire C: drive

Click **FIND NOW**

Once the results come up, double-click on the **COOKIES FOLDER** to open it

Delete **ALL** of the files (certain DAT files may not delete)

** If you have more than one COOKIES folder, do the same thing for all of the folders.

Netscape

Click on the **START** button, then **FIND, FILES OR FOLDERS**

In the named filed type **COOKIES.TXT**

Make sure the **LOOK IN** filed is set to look in the entire C: drive

Click **FIND NOW**

Once the results come up, delete ALL occurrences of COOKIES.TXT

The easy way:

1. Click right button on the **START** button, then choice Explore, on folder section, move down until find **TEMP** folder and 1 click to open it, now select 1 file on right site, hold Ctrl + A (letter A) to select all and press DEL.
2. Now move down until find **TEMPORARY INTERNET** folder and 1 click to open it, now select 1 file on right site, hold Ctrl + A (letter A) to select all and press DEL.

Clearing Cookie Files in a MACINTOSH

Internet Explorer

Open **IE**,

Click **EDIT**, then **PREFERENCES**

Then double-click on **RECEIVING FILES** to expand your options

Hit **OPEN-APPLE -A**, to select all the COOKIES,

Then hit **DELETE** on key board

Netscape

Click on **APPLE ICON**

Click on **FIND FILE**, then type in **COOKIE**

In the Items found section, find **MAGICCOOKIE**

Then drag it into the trash
